Proof of Insurance Form

Adequate health and accident insurance is required for any student going on a study abroad program. Decisions regarding the type, scope, and duration of this coverage should be left to the student and her or his family or guardians. Many students already have insurance policies that cover them abroad or that offer add-on coverage at a rate much lower than an individual policy. Students should contact their insurance company for information about current or optional coverage. For those who do not have adequate coverage, there are many policies available specifically for study abroad, and they can be purchased for exactly the period of time that the student will be abroad. We recommend that any policy include basic medical, accidental death and dismemberment, emergency evacuation, and repatriation coverage.

We also strongly recommend that students take the ISIC card, which can be obtained through STA Travel. The International Student Identity Card not only provides some basic health insurance and emergency services coverage, but can also be used by students for discounts at museums and on transportation within Europe.
