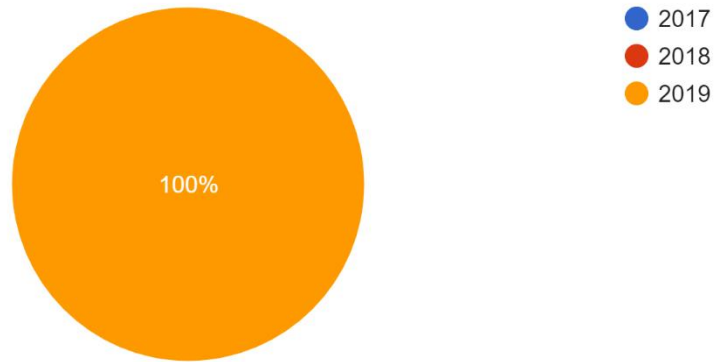

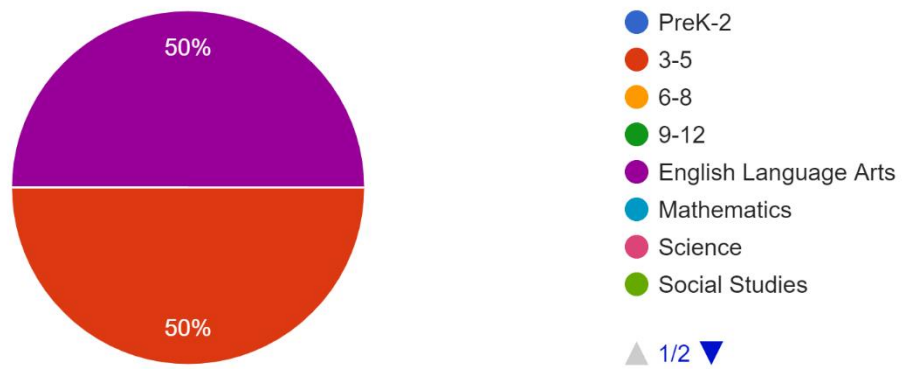
Initial year of teacher's employment?

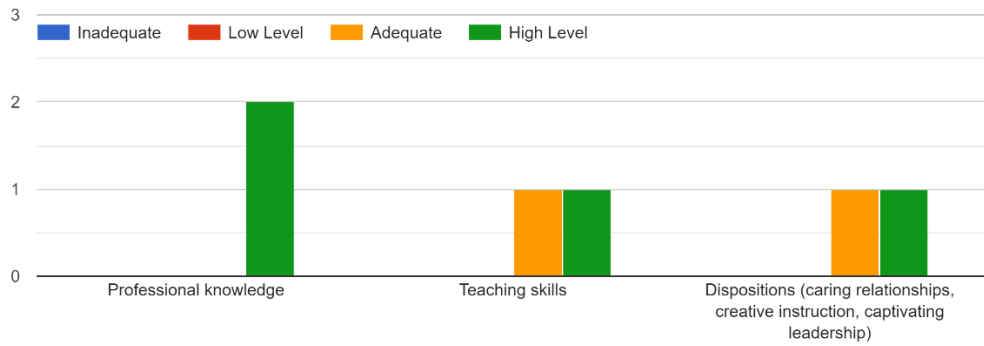


What subject(s)/grade(s) is the teacher currently teaching?

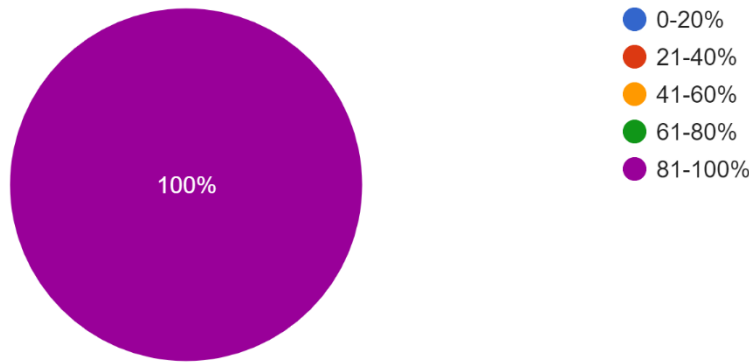

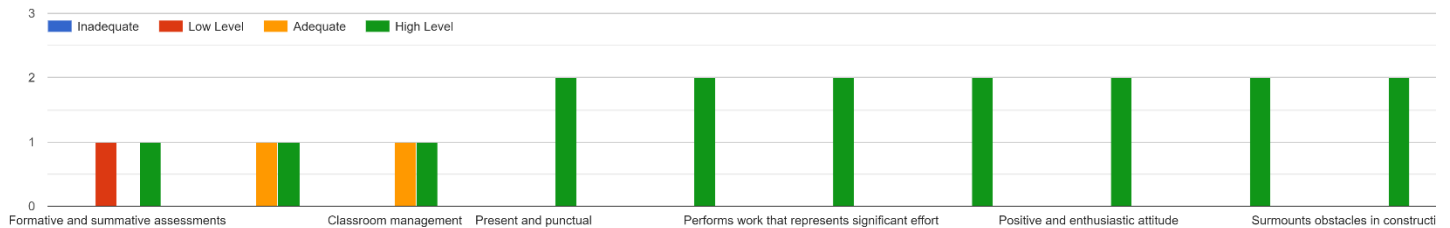
