Description

Erskine College invites applicants to join the adjunct pool for the English Department. The majority of courses taught by adjunct instructors are EN101 (Freshman Composition) and EN102 (Composition and Literature). However, applicants are invited to specify their areas of expertise; instructors of EN101 and/or 102 may occasionally have the opportunity to teach a literature course in their field, depending on department needs.

Responsibilities

- Adjuncts may teach up to 3 courses per semester (course load is determined by the adjunct based on availability)
- Adjuncts can choose to teach online or in person; online classes may be primarily asynchronous but generally have some synchronous components

Qualifications

- Possession of a master's or doctoral degree, or current enrollment in such a degree program
- At least 18 hours of graduate credit in the discipline of English
- A personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- Commitment to Erskine's vision and mission
- Willingness to offer spiritual support to students
