Responsibilities

Teaching load of 24 credit hours per year, with in person teaching of lecture and lab. Teaching responsibilities initially include introductory biology for science majors, Senior Seminar, and courses in field of specialty. Additional responsibilities include departmental, institutional, and church/community service. Faculty members are expected to embrace and support the Erskine mission statement.
