Description

Erskine College invites applicants to join the adjunct pool for the Music Department. The majority of courses taught by adjunct instructors are applied lessons in the field of expertise (brass, woodwinds, strings, percussion and guitar), MU 143 (Sinfonia- conductor of this ensemble), MU 145 (Jazz Band- conductor of this ensemble), MU217 (Instrumental Music Pedagogy and Literature), MU218 (Instrumental Methods- Brass and Woodwinds), MU219 (Instrumental Methods- Strings and Percussion). Applicants are invited to specify their areas of expertise; applied music instructors occasionally have the opportunity to teach additional courses in their field, depending on department needs. Individuals with a music education degree and previous public school teaching experience are desired.

Responsibilities

- Adjuncts may teach up to 3 courses per semester (course load is determined by the adjunct based on availability)
- Applied instructors can choose to teach online or in person, but face-to-face instruction is preferred; online classes may be primarily asynchronous but generally have some synchronous components.

Qualifications

- Possession of a master's or doctoral degree, or current enrollment in such a degree program
- At least 18 hours of graduate credit in the discipline of Music
- A personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- Commitment to Erskine's vision and mission
- Willingness to offer spiritual support to students
