Description

Responsibilities

- Average 3-3 course load in fall and spring semesters and 1-2 course load in summer semester
- Courses taught will depend on expertise but may include: Counseling and Helping Relationships, Diagnostics of Psychopathology and Treatment Planning, Group Therapies, Addictions, Family Systems, Child and Adolescent Psychopathology, etc.
- Supervision of practicums and internships
- Academic and career advising

Qualifications

- Ability to begin teaching August 2026
- A Ph.D. in Counselor Education and Supervision
- Licensed or eligible for licensure in South Carolina as a Licensed Professional Counselor
- A personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- Ability to teach courses from a Christian worldview
- Ability to teach in both face-to-face and online environments
- Preferably a strong background in teaching
- Willingness to offer spiritual support to students
